

Team 341 Travel Policy (2004)

1) Student Travel List

A list will be sent out via email no later than 2/21/04 detailing the events to which students have been assigned. These assignments will be based on part time/ full time status, student/parent requests, team staffing requirements, student readiness to travel, student academic standing and merit. Please review this list carefully when it is posted and decide if your child should attend the events for which they have been assigned.

2) Parent Meeting

At least one legal guardian of each student must attend a Travel Meeting on 2/5/04 at 7:00 PM in room C-30, WHS. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the logistics of the upcoming travel season and confirm your approval for student travel.

3) Financial Policy

The following student travel contributions have been instituted for the 2004 season.

a) Students going to Philadelphia Regional Competition Only: No Fees

b) Students going to the Chesapeake Regional Competition: \$150 non-refundable travel fee, due by 3/2/04

c) Students going to the FIRST National Championship, Atlanta, GA: \$250 non-refundable travel fee, due by 3/2/04

4) Student Conduct: Students that attend competition trips must conduct themselves in accordance with school guidelines. All school rules apply. (A copy of WHS school policies can be found in the WHS Agenda Book) These expectations will also apply to NMTCC students. Students that commit major violations of these policies (i.e. substance abuse, fighting, etc.) will be sent home immediately at the parent's expense. Should a student be sent home early based on behavior or refusal to follow directions, the fee would not be refunded.

5) Trip Attendance

Students must travel to and from the events with the team. Students should attend the competition for all of the days assigned and for the entire competition day. Under extreme circumstances, partial attendance will be allowed at regional events on a case-by-case basis. Partial attendance will only be allowed provided that the parent supplies Adult Supervised transportation for the student, to and from the event.

No partial attendance will be allowed for the National Competition.
